Martin Luther encouraged preaching on the catechisms, especially during Lent. Using the catechisms as a basis for midweek Lenten worship provides an opportunity to revisit some of the basic teachings of the Christian community. In addition to Luther's Small and Large Catechisms we will also use some of Luther's hymns, prayers and insights for the series. Except for Ash Wednesday, we will use the Service of Word and Prayer from WOV.
